- ✓ Gross motor play – park, climbing, hanging – holding their body weight, monkey-bars, pedalling, scooting, swimming



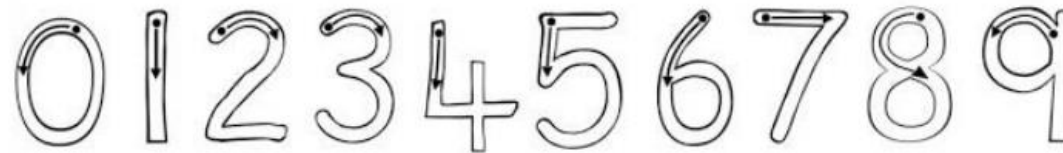
- ✓ Pencil grip – same for left and right handed

"C shaped letter family"



a is formed with "a big fat tummy; straight up, straight down and add a flick; make sure he has a straight back". g has "a monkey tail; tuck it under." s starts with a "little c". You may remind children to form d with the correct orientation by saying "curly c becomes a d (using the letter names in both cases)"

Numeral formation at Bernards Heath Infant and Nursery School




1 is "a straight line down"
