Our Themed Learning: We will be learning about South America focusing particularly on Peru. The children will learn about wildlife in the rainforest, amazon tribes, and the history of Machu Picchu. We will create maps with grid references and have an exciting visit from Ranger Paul who will bring some of his creepy crawly friends. The children will be learning to ask questions, investigate, record, explain and create.

Learning in the Core Subjects

- In English we will be learning to write stories, focusing on improving our sentence construction by using adverbs, verbs and conjunctions.
- In Maths we will be using our number knowledge to investigate inverse (subtraction and addition) and missing numbers. We will be problem solving, reasoning and showing our learning in different ways (through numbers, pictures and objects).
- In Science we will be finding out about plants and animals.
- In Computing we will be learning about the importance of e-safety.
