How our learning will link to Verulam class children's lives, interests and experiences

- Children have been exploring taking pictures and learning to print, using the laptops and iPads
- Children have begun to engage in lots more cooperative construction to build higher and higher towers and longer and longer 'rivers' using pipes for water
- Role-play has been really popular; children re-enacting traditional tales inside and outside
- Children have been talking lots about wobbly teeth, birthdays and ages; we'll be talking about months of the year and what age one more year/2 more years would make everyone

How our learning will link to the wider world

- We will explore the technology throughout the school; how the printer connects to the network, and where children's work is actually saved by looking in the server cupboard
- We will explore a variety of team games in P.E., taking turns and supporting teammates so that we all help to achieve a common goal
- We will learn the concepts of doubling and halving with shapes and then with numbers, as well as practising one more or less than any number to 20

15th May is **Walk to School Week** - Please remember to park a little further away if possible. Children will be collecting stickers as a class.

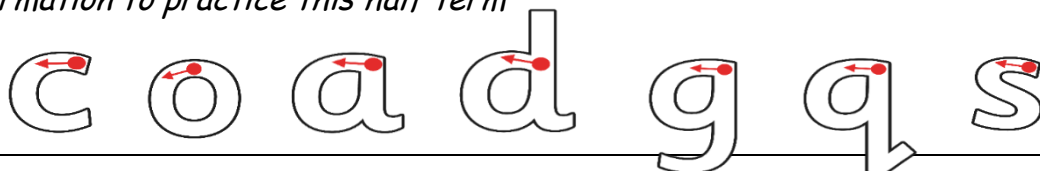
Letters and Sounds

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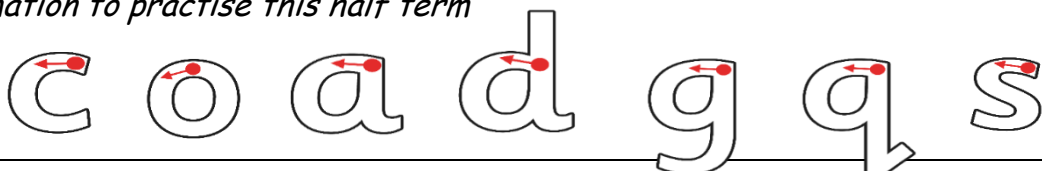
