Public Health England lead the child measurement programme and gather data about children's weight and height in Reception and Year 6. This data is collected by school nurses as part of the reception screening programme that also checks sight and hearing. Public Health England now have three years of data and can produce reliable estimates of overweight and obesity. The data for our school shows that levels of overweight and obesity are below figures for Herts and England.
