How our learning will link to our children's lives, interests and experiences

- Our carpet time continues to be a wonderful opportunity for us all to say hello and look at our visual timetable for the day. We also sing our days of the week, weather and number song. This half term our number song is Five Little Men in a Flying Saucer.
- Our theme of Fireworks will link to the children's own experiences of Fireworks and Bonfire night. We will be asking the children to share their thoughts and feelings relating to any previous experiences they have had. We have watched a variety of Fireworks displays on our Smartboard at carpet time so the children will use these as a talking point too.

How our learning will link to the wider world

- We began by reading books about Fireworks and Bonfire night and we also explored and watched real
 displays as a group. We will, over the coming weeks, share Our Learning Hero stories with the children;
 discovering the qualities of perseverance (Duck), concentration & focus (Dog), friendly behaviours (Bear)

 and understanding of our themes.
