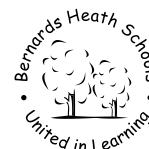


## BERNARDS HEATH INFANT & NURSERY SCHOOL

This term all sports clubs will be outside as much as possible; please send in appropriate clothing – sunhats may be needed.

**FS2** need to bring trainers for sports clubs but **do not** need to change into a different kit – their uniform is already appropriate for sports clubs.

Parents are not able to stay at school during any club but please arrive in good time to collect your child. Please meet your child at the Quiet Room outside door or appropriate classroom as advised in the letter of confirmation.

**If there is not enough interest shown for a particular club we reserve the right to cancel it.**

You will see we have stated the total number of spaces available on each club. This is to help parents understand why it isn't possible for every child to be allocated their first choice. Whilst we are extremely proud of the number of clubs we offer, on some occasions we have over 200 children choosing to attend a club with just 12 spaces.

**Initially each child may join one club. If you wish your child to attend more than one club you must state this on the attached form.** If there is space, your child may be allocated an additional club place – please read our allocation policy to understand more.

The clubs we organise as a school provide children with opportunities to learn new, age-appropriate skills in many different areas of learning. We encourage children in our 3.15pm clubs to bring along a drink and a small healthy snack that can be finished in 5 minutes so as to get as much learning from the session as possible.

A brief outline of our clubs:

<b>Lego</b> Miss Hart	Children will be exploring the many uses of Lego and taking on new Lego challenges. There will be a different theme each week ranging from creating mazes to building models. <b>Due to the popularity of lego club at school, children who have not attended this club before will be given priority.</b>
<b>Drama and Musical Theatre</b> Miss Flanagan	Develop creativity and imagination. Use music and role-play based on popular stories to develop speaking and listening skills, as well as growing in confidence and self-esteem.
<b>Music and Dance Time</b> Miss Flanagan	Children will listen to a range of music, create dances and move with rhythm, interpreting what they have heard.
<b>The Story Bakers (Cooking)</b> Mrs Player and Mrs Sinnott	Cooking exciting recipes linked to well-known children's stories. <b>Due to the popularity of cooking clubs at school, children who have not attended a cooking club before will be given priority.</b>  There is an additional charge for this club to cover the cost of ingredients.
<b>Ukulele</b> Miss Hart	Learn to play the ukulele! Look at chords, strumming patterns and learn a range of fun songs. <b>This club is for children who have not attended before.</b>
<b>Football</b> Mr Gunn	A hugely popular club choice. We will be offering an 8am football club for Y1/Y2 to accommodate the large number of children who choose to attend football club at school.
<b>Hockey</b> Mr Gunn	Children will develop agility and coordination whilst learning the skills of this engaging team game.
<b>Basketball</b> Mr Gunn	An opportunity to develop throwing and catching skills, as well as team-building, in this pacey sport.
<b>Tag Rugby</b> Mr Gunn	Children will have the chance to develop passing, off-loading and decision-making skills whilst having lots of fun!
<b>FS2 Construction</b> Miss Hart	Children will be given the opportunity to explore a range of construction tools such as Lego, Octons and K'nex.
<b>iPad</b> Miss Hart	Explore the features of an iPad; use a different App every week! Features such as film-making will also be explored.

We need your replies by **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2017**. This is the final deadline as places will be allocated and it will be too late to change your mind/swap your preferences after this date. Confirmation letters will be emailed to you via SchoolComms (Gateway app) week commencing **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2017**.

After the term has begun we cannot swap and change club places so please choose carefully.
