How our learning will link to our children's lives, interests and experiences

- Our morning carpet time is a wonderful opportunity for us all to get to know each other. At this time, the children share a little about their own personal experiences from the weekend or day before. It is also an opportunity to share their show and tell and find out about the day ahead.
- Our Personal, Social and Emotional (PSE) theme is friendships as this is something that is so important at
 this point of the year. The children are meeting many new children and making friends. We will be using
 books to help support the making of new friendships and helping us understand one another's feelings
 around friendships.
- Science Week is a whole school event where we will be focusing on Water. The children will think about
 water in many different ways; doing WOW experiments, weather, planting, saving water and underwater
 animals.

How our learning will link to the wider world

- We will begin by reading books about friendship and using the main theme of each book to prompt our talk and understanding What do you need to do to be a good friend? How do you ask someone to play with you?
- In science week there will be lots of hands on experience with water; investigating ice balloons, adding colouring to water, finding out about the weather and visiting and tending to our vegetable patch. We will also be thinking about animals that live in water and how we can save water. Why do we get puddles on our playground? Where does the water go? How can we make the ice melt faster?
