**If there is not enough interest shown for a particular club we reserve the right to cancel it.**

You will need to book your child/children straight onto an after school club through your Schoolcomms account (this can be accessed from a computer or your gateway app). Go to the club you would like to book, and select the entire 10 sessions in order to book your place. Once you have done this you need to make your payment. **Payment must be made at the time of booking. Please do not go straight to the payment screen. You must select your 10 sessions first.** Your place is not confirmed until the payment has been made. **We are unable to accept childcare vouchers for any after school activity clubs that we run, however these can be redeemed with the Bernards Heath Childcare provision.**

In line with Breakfast Club and Bernards Heath Childcare we are unable to offer refunds for unattended sessions. In exceptional circumstances a refund will be given at the discretion of the Head Teacher. After the term has begun we cannot swap and change club places so please choose carefully.

Our aim is for as many children as possible to attend an after school club. The number of children attending a club will continue to be limited. Initially you will be able to sign your child/children up to attend **ONE** club only, to ensure everyone has an equal chance (multiple bookings will be deleted). All clubs will go live for bookings on **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March**. Schoolcomms does not allow us to make all clubs live at the same time and therefore they need to be entered manually club by club. We aim to start this process around 10.00am and will work through until all clubs are live. It would be appreciated if you did not call the office with club queries during this time, as this will delay the process. As of Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March, you are free to book additional club places for your child.

Musical Theatre will continue for the children who are currently attending. If any spaces become available we will advertise these in our newsletter. Mad Science currently hold a waiting list and will be in contact with you to see if you are still interested in attending. Again, if spaces do become available we will advertise in our newsletter.

Children attending Bernards Heath Childcare will no longer have an option to attend an extra-curricular club beforehand. This is due to staffing, ratios and finance. There will be plenty of opportunities for active games inside and out (tennis, football, exploring nature and team games), arts and crafts and quiet and restful activities.

If you do not have the technology to access the school gateway, or need any help booking a place, there will be a laptop available at school for you to use on **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March** from 1.00pm, when we are hoping all clubs will be on the system.

Things your child will need:

**FS2** children do **not** need a change of clothes – their uniform is suitable for all activities. Sports clubs will be outside as much as possible; please send in appropriate clothing.

The clubs we organise as a school provide children with opportunities to learn new, age-appropriate skills in many different areas of learning. We encourage children in our 3.15pm clubs to bring along a drink and a small healthy snack that can be finished in 5 minutes so as to get as much learning from the session as possible. Please remember we are a **nut free school**.

A brief outline of our clubs:

<b>Arts and Crafts</b> Mrs Aide (FS2) Miss Keeton(Y1, Y2)	Children will have fun creating art and craft items using lots of different materials and mediums.
<b>Athletics</b> Mr Mabbitt	Children will try a range of different games and events such as jumping, hurdles and running races.
<b>Lego</b> Mrs Aide	Children will be exploring the many uses of Lego and taking on new Lego challenges. There will be a different theme each week ranging from creating mazes to building models.
<b>Tennis</b> Mr Mabbitt	Children will develop their hand eye co-ordination and learn a range of new racket skills.
<b>Rounders</b> Mr Mabbitt	This is a massively fun game in which children will improve their team work and communication.
<b>Football</b> Mr Mabbitt	A hugely popular club choice.
