**The Nasal Spray Vaccinations are taking place on Tuesday 17th November with any catch up sessions for children who were absent or refused on Monday 14th December. Vaccination UK have given us the following advice regarding possible side effects.**

If there is a rise in temperature, calpol will need to be given and if the temperature comes down, it will be a reaction to the vaccine. If the temperature persists for 24-48 hrs and calpol has been continually given to the child during this time, then the parent will need to arrange to get a Covid-19 test. However if the temperature subsides then the child will not need to be tested and can return to school as normal.
